**Doctrinal Commitments #1 – #17 of the Church of God Total: 77 verses**

## **1. Repentance**

- 1) Mark 1:15 “The time has come,” he said. “The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!”
- 2) Luke 13:3 I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish.
- 3) Acts 3:19 Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord,

## **2. Justification**

- 4) Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we<sup>[a]</sup> have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 5) Titus 3:7 so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

## **3. Regeneration**

- 6) Titus 3:5 he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit,  
[2 points]

#### **4. New Birth**

- 7) John 3:3 In reply Jesus declared, “I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again.”
- 8) 1 Peter 1:23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.
- 9) 1 John 3:9 No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God’s seed remains in him; he cannot go on sinning, because he has been born of God.

#### **5. Sanctification subsequent to justification**

- 10) Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 11) Romans 5:2 through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand...
- 12) 1 Thessalonians 4:3 It is God’s will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality;
- 13) 1 Thessalonians 4:4 that each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable,
- 14) 1 Thessalonians 4:5 not in passionate lust like the heathen, who do not know God;
- 15) Hebrews 13:12 And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to *make the people holy through his own blood.*

#### **6. Holiness**

- 16) 1 Thessalonians 4:7 For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.
- 17) Hebrews 12:14 Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.

## **7. Water Baptism**

- 18) Matthew 28:19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- 19) Mark 1:9 At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.
- 20) Mark 16:16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

## **8. Baptism with the Holy Ghost subsequent to cleansing; the enduement of power for service.**

- 21) Matthew 3:11 “I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me comes one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. [2 points]
- 22) Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” [2 points]

## **9. The speaking in tongues as the Spirit gives utterance as the initial evidence of the baptism in the Holy Ghost.**

- 23) Acts 2:4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.
- 24) Acts 10:44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message.
- 25) Acts 10:45 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles.
- 26) Acts 10:46 For they heard them speaking in tongues<sup>[a]</sup> and praising God.

## 10. The Church

- 27) Matthew 16:18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.
- 28) Acts 2:42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.
- 29) Acts 2:43 Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles.
- 30) Acts 2:44 All the believers were together and had everything in common.
- 31) Acts 2:45 They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need.
- 32) Acts 2:46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, [2 points]
- 33) Acts 2:47 praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved. [2 points]
- 34) Acts 20:28 Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood. [2 points]
- 35) 1 Corinthians 12:12 The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ. [2 points]
- 36) 1 Corinthians 12:27 Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it.
- 37) 1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. [2 points]

## **11.Spiritual Gifts**

- 38) 1 Corinthians 12:1 Now about spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be ignorant.
- 39) 1 Corinthians 12:4 There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- 40) 1 Corinthians 12:5 There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord.
- 41) 1 Corinthians 12:6 There are different kinds of working, but the same God works all of them in all men.
- 42) 1 Corinthians 12:7 Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.
- 43) 1 Corinthians 12:8 To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit,
- 44) 1 Corinthians 12:9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit,
- 45) 1 Corinthians 12:10 to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. [2 points]
- 46) 1 Corinthians 12:11 All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he gives them to each one, just as he determines.

## **12.Signs following believers**

- 47) Mark 16:17 And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues;
- 48) Mark 16:18 they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.” [2 points]
- 49) Mark 16:19 After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God.
- 50) Mark 16:20 Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.

### **13.Fruit of the Spirit**

- 51) Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- 52) Galatians 5:23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.
- 53) Galatians 5:24 Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires.
- 54) Galatians 5:25 Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.
- 55) Galatians 5:26 Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other.

### **14.Divine healing provided for all in the Atonement**

- 56) James 5:14 Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord.
- 57) James 5:15 And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up...

### **15.The Lord's Supper**

- 58) 1 Corinthians 11:23 ...The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread,
- 59) 1 Corinthians 11:24 and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me."
- 60) 1 Corinthians 11:25 In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."
- 61) 1 Corinthians 11:26 For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

- 62) 1 Corinthians 11:27 Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.
- 63) 1 Corinthians 11:28 A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup.
- 64) 1 Corinthians 11:29 For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment on himself.
- 65) 1 Corinthians 11:30 That is why many among you are weak and sick, and a number of you have fallen asleep.
- 66) 1 Corinthians 11:31 But if we judged ourselves, we would not come under judgment.
- 67) 1 Corinthians 11:32 When we are judged by the Lord, we are being disciplined so that we will not be condemned with the world.

## **16. Washing the saints' feet**

- 68) John 13:4 so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist.
- 69) John 13:5 After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him.
- 70) John 13:6 He came to Simon Peter, who said to him, "Lord, are you going to wash my feet?"
- 71) John 13:7 Jesus replied, "You do not realize now what I am doing, but later you will understand."
- 72) John 13:8 "No," said Peter, "you shall never wash my feet." Jesus answered, "Unless I wash you, you have no part with me."

## **17. Tithing and giving**

- 73) Malachi 3:8 “Will a man rob God? Yet you rob me. “But you ask, ‘How do we rob you?’ “In tithes and offerings.
- 74) Malachi 3:9 You are under a curse—the whole nation of you—because you are robbing me.
- 75) Malachi 3:10 Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the LORD Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it. [2 points]
- 76) 2 Corinthians 9:6 Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.
- 77) 2 Corinthians 9:7 Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
