- 1) Isaiah 40:29 He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.
- 2) Isaiah 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD, and apart from me there is no savior.
- 3) Isaiah 60:1 "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.
- 4) Psalm 1:1 Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers.
- 5) Psalm 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.
- 6) Psalm 2:8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.
- 7) Psalm 5:4 You are not a God who takes pleasure in evil; with you the wicked cannot dwell.
- 8) Psalm 5:7 But I, by your great mercy, will come into your house; in reverence will I bow down toward your holy temple.

- 9) Psalm 5:12 For surely, O LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.
- 10) Psalm 6:9 The LORD has heard my cry for mercy; the LORD accepts my prayer.
- 11) Psalm 7:17 I will give thanks to the LORD because of his righteousness and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High.
- 12) Psalm 8:1 O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.
- 13) Psalm 8:3 When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place,
- 14) Psalm 8:4 what is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him?
- 15) Psalm 9:1 I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonders.
- 16) Psalm 9:9 The LORD is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble.
- 17) Psalm 9:10 Those who know your name will trust in you, for you, LORD, have never forsaken those who seek you.
- 18) Psalm 11:4 The LORD is in his holy temple; the LORD is on his heavenly throne. He observes the sons of men; his eyes examine them.
- 19) Psalm 15:1 LORD, who may dwell in your sanctuary? Who may live on your holy hill?
- 20) Psalm 15:2 He whose walk is blameless and who does what is righteous, who speaks the truth from his heart
- 21) Psalm 16:2 I said to the LORD, "You are my Lord; apart from you I have no good thing."
- 22) Psalm 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.

- 23) Psalm 17:8 Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings
- 24) Psalm 18:27 You save the humble but bring low those whose eyes are haughty.
- 25) Psalm 18:29 With your help I can advance against a troop; with my God I can scale a wall.
- 26) Psalm 20:7 Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.
- 27) Psalm 32:1 Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.
- 28) Psalm 47:2 How awesome is the LORD Most High, the great King over all the earth!
- 29) Psalm 55:16 But I call to God, and the LORD saves me.
- 30) Psalm 61:1 Hear my cry, O God; listen to my prayer.
- 31) Psalm 66:1 Shout with joy to God, all the earth!
- 32) Psalm 91:2 I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
- 33) Psalm 107:1 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.
- 34) Psalm 115:3 Our God is in heaven; he does whatever pleases him.
- 35) Psalm 118:8 It is better to take refuge in the LORD than to trust in man.
- 36) Psalm 118:9 It is better to take refuge in the LORD than to trust in princes.
- 37) Psalm 119:11 I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.
- 38) Psalm 119:147 I rise before dawn and cry for help; I have put my hope in your word.
- 39) Psalm 122:1 I rejoiced with those who said to me, "Let us go to the house of the LORD."

- 40) Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;
- 41) Proverbs 3:6 in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.
- 42) Proverbs 3:7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil.
- 43) Proverbs 15:1 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.
- 44) Proverbs 15:13 A happy heart makes the face cheerful, but heartache crushes the spirit.
- 45) Proverbs 16:3 Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and your plans will succeed.
- 46) Proverbs 18:10 The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.
- 47) Proverbs 19:21 Many are the plans in a man's heart, but it is the LORD's purpose that prevails.
- 48) Proverbs 21:3 To do what is right and just is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.
- 49) Proverbs 22:4 Humility and the fear of the LORD bring wealth and honor and life.
- 50) Matthew 4:19 "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men."
- 51) Matthew 4:20 At once they left their nets and followed him.
- 52) Matthew 5:3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 53) Matthew 5:4 Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- 54) Matthew 5:5 Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.
- 55) Matthew 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- 56) Matthew 5:7 Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

- 57) Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.
- 58) Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.
- 59) Matthew 5:10 Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 60) Matthew 6:14 For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.
- 61) Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
- 62) Matthew 6:22 "The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are good, your whole body will be full of light.
- 63) Matthew 6:33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
- 64) Matthew 7:1 "Do not judge, or you too will be judged.
- 65) Matthew 7:7 "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.
- 66) Matthew 7:17 Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.
- 67) Matthew 9:37 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few.
- 68) Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
- 69) Matthew 18:4 Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
- 70) Matthew 18:20 For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them."
- 71) Matthew 21:22 If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer."

- 72) Matthew 22:37 Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."
- 73) Matthew 22:38 This is the first and greatest commandment.
- 74) Matthew 22:39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'
- 75) Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.
