**Isaiah (13 verses), Matthew (58 verses), Psalms (39 verses), Proverbs (15 verses);
Total: 125 verses**

- 1) Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.
- 2) Isaiah 40:29 He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.
- 3) Isaiah 40:30 Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;
- 4) Isaiah 40:31 but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
- 5) Isaiah 41:13 For I am the LORD, your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you.
- 6) Isaiah 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD, and apart from me there is no savior.
- 7) Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!"
- 8) Isaiah 55:8 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD.

- 9) Isaiah 55:9 "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.
- 10) Isaiah 59:1 Surely the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear.
- 11) Isaiah 60:1 "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.
- 12) Isaiah 64:4 Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides you, who acts on behalf of those who wait for him.
- 13) Isaiah 64:8 Yet, O LORD, you are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand.
- 14) Matthew 4:7 Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'"
- 15) Matthew 4:10 Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'"
- 16) Matthew 4:17 From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near."
- 17) Matthew 4:19 "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men."
- 18) Matthew 4:20 At once they left their nets and followed him.
- 19) Matthew 5:3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit,
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 20) Matthew 5:4 Blessed are those who mourn,
for they will be comforted.
- 21) Matthew 5:5 Blessed are the meek,
for they will inherit the earth.

- 22) Matthew 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness,
for they will be filled.
- 23) Matthew 5:7 Blessed are the merciful,
for they will be shown mercy.
- 24) Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart,
for they will see God.
- 25) Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers,
for they will be called sons of God.
- 26) Matthew 5:10 Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness,
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 27) Matthew 5:11 "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say
all kinds of evil against you because of me.
- 28) Matthew 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your
good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.
- 29) Matthew 5:37 Simply let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No'; anything beyond this
comes from the evil one.
- 30) Matthew 5:42 Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who
wants to borrow from you.
- 31) Matthew 5:44 But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute
you,
- 32) Matthew 6:14 For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father
will also forgive you.
- 33) Matthew 6:20 But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do
not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.
- 34) Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

- 35) Matthew 6:22 "The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are good, your whole body will be full of light.
- 36) Matthew 6:33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
- 37) Matthew 7:1 "Do not judge, or you too will be judged.
- 38) Matthew 7:2 For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.
- 39) Matthew 7:7 "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.
- 40) Matthew 7:8 For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened.
- 41) Matthew 7:14 But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.
- 42) Matthew 7:17 Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.
- 43) Matthew 7:20 Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them.
- 44) Matthew 7:21 "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.
- 45) Matthew 8:26 He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.
- 46) Matthew 9:37 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few.
- 47) Matthew 10:22 All men will hate you because of me, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.

- 48) Matthew 10:39 Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.
- 49) Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
- 50) Matthew 11:30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."
- 51) Matthew 14:27 But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid."
- 52) Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.
- 53) Matthew 16:25 whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it.
- 54) Matthew 16:26 What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul?
- 55) Matthew 16:27 For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done.
- 56) Matthew 18:3 And he said: "I tell you the truth, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.
- 57) Matthew 18:4 Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
- 58) Matthew 18:20 For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them."
- 59) Matthew 19:14 Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."
- 60) Matthew 19:24 Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."

- 61) Matthew 19:26 Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
- 62) Matthew 20:16 "So the last will be first, and the first will be last."
- 63) Matthew 20:26 Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant,
- 64) Matthew 21:22 If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer."
- 65) Matthew 22:37 Jesus replied: " 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.'
- 66) Matthew 22:39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'
- 67) Matthew 23:12 For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.
- 68) Matthew 24:13 but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.
- 69) Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.
- 70) Matthew 25:45 "He will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.'
- 71) Matthew 28:19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- 72) Psalm 1:1 Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers.
- 73) Psalm 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.
- 74) Psalm 1:3 He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.
- 75) Psalm 1:4 Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.

- 76) Psalm 1:5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
- 77) Psalm 1:6 For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.
- 78) Psalm 2:8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.
- 79) Psalm 5:4 You are not a God who takes pleasure in evil; with you the wicked cannot dwell.
- 80) Psalm 5:7 But I, by your great mercy, will come into your house; in reverence will I bow down toward your holy temple.
- 81) Psalm 5:12 For surely, O LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.
- 82) Psalm 6:9 The LORD has heard my cry for mercy; the LORD accepts my prayer.
- 83) Psalm 7:17 I will give thanks to the LORD because of his righteousness and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High.
- 84) Psalm 8:1 O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.
- 85) Psalm 8:3 When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place,
- 86) Psalm 8:4 what is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him?
- 87) Psalm 9:1 I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonders.
- 88) Psalm 9:9 The LORD is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble.

- 89) Psalm 9:10 Those who know your name will trust in you, for you, LORD, have never forsaken those who seek you.
- 90) Psalm 11:4 The LORD is in his holy temple; the LORD is on his heavenly throne. He observes the sons of men; his eyes examine them.
- 91) Psalm 15:1 LORD, who may dwell in your sanctuary? Who may live on your holy hill?
- 92) Psalm 15:2 He whose walk is blameless and who does what is righteous, who speaks the truth from his heart
- 93) Psalm 16:2 I said to the LORD, "You are my Lord; apart from you I have no good thing."
- 94) Psalm 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.
- 95) Psalm 17:8 Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings
- 96) Psalm 18:2 The LORD is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge. He is my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.
- 97) Psalm 18:27 You save the humble but bring low those whose eyes are haughty.
- 98) Psalm 18:29 With your help I can advance against a troop; with my God I can scale a wall.
- 99) Psalm 18:30 As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is flawless. He is a shield for all who take refuge in him.
- 100) Psalm 19:8 The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes.
- 101) Psalm 19:9 The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure and altogether righteous.

- 102) Psalm 19:14 May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer.
- 103) Psalm 20:6 Now I know that the LORD saves his anointed; he answers him from his holy heaven with the saving power of his right hand.
- 104) Psalm 20:7 Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.
- 105) Psalm 25:5 guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long.
- 106) Psalm 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?
- 107) Psalm 27:4 One thing I ask of the LORD, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.
- 108) Psalm 28:7 The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song.
- 109) Psalm 31:19 How great is your goodness, which you have stored up for those who fear you, which you bestow in the sight of men on those who take refuge in you.
- 110) Psalm 32:1 Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.
- 111) Proverbs 2:6 For the LORD gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding.
- 112) Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;
- 113) Proverbs 3:6 in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.
- 114) Proverbs 3:7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil.

- 115) Proverbs 15:1 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.
- 116) Proverbs 15:13 A happy heart makes the face cheerful, but heartache crushes the spirit.
- 117) Proverbs 16:3 Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and your plans will succeed.
- 118) Proverbs 18:10 The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.
- 119) Proverbs 19:21 Many are the plans in a man's heart, but it is the LORD's purpose that prevails.
- 120) Proverbs 21:3 To do what is right and just is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.
- 121) Proverbs 22:4 Humility and the fear of the LORD bring wealth and honor and life.
- 122) Proverbs 27:1 Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth.
- 123) Proverbs 28:14 Blessed is the man who always fears the LORD, but he who hardens his heart falls into trouble.
- 124) Proverbs 30:5 "Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.
- 125) Proverbs 31:8 "Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute.
