Isaiah (66 verses), Psalms (40 verses), Proverbs (19 verses); Total: 125 verses

- 1) Isaiah 1:18 "Come now, let us reason together," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.
- 2) Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.
- 3) Isaiah 8:17 I will wait for the LORD, who is hiding his face from the house of Jacob. I will put my trust in him.
- 4) Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
- 5) Isaiah 12:2 Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The LORD, the LORD, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation."
- 6) Isaiah 12:5 Sing to the LORD, for he has done glorious things; let this be known to all the world.
- 7) Isaiah 12:6 Shout aloud and sing for joy, people of Zion, for great is the Holy One of Israel among you."

- 8) Isaiah 25:1 O LORD, you are my God; I will exalt you and praise your name, for in perfect faithfulness you have done marvelous things, things planned long ago.
- 9) Isaiah 26:3 You will keep in perfect peace, him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you.
- 10) Isaiah 26:4 Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD, the LORD, is the Rock eternal.
- 11) Isaiah 26:12 LORD, you establish peace for us; all that we have accomplished you have done for us.
- 12) Isaiah 30:21 Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way; walk in it."
- 13) Isaiah 33:2 O LORD, be gracious to us; we long for you. Be our strength every morning, our salvation in time of distress.
- 14) Isaiah 40:12 Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens? Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance?
- 15) Isaiah 40:13 Who has understood the mind of the LORD, or instructed him as his counselor?
- 16) Isaiah 40:14 Whom did the LORD consult to enlighten him, and who taught him the right way? Who was it that taught him knowledge or showed him the path of understanding?
- 17) Isaiah 40:15 Surely the nations are like a drop in a bucket; they are regarded as dust on the scales; he weighs the islands as though they were fine dust.
- 18) Isaiah 40:18 To whom, then, will you compare God? What image will you compare him to?

- 19) Isaiah 40:26 Lift your eyes and look to the heavens: Who created all these? He who brings out the starry host one by one, and calls them each by name. Because of his great power and mighty strength, not one of them is missing.
- 20) Isaiah 40:28 Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom.
- 21) Isaiah 40:29 He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.
- 22) Isaiah 40:30 Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;
- 23) Isaiah 40:31 but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
- 24) Isaiah 41:10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
- 25) Isaiah 41:13 For I am the LORD, your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you.
- 26) Isaiah 41:18 I will make rivers flow on barren heights, and springs within the valleys. I will turn the desert into pools of water, and the parched ground into springs.
- 27) Isaiah 41:20 so that people may see and know, may consider and understand, that the hand of the LORD has done this, that the Holy One of Israel has created it.
- 28) Isaiah 42:6 "I, the LORD, have called you in righteousness; I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles,

- 29) Isaiah 42:7 to open eyes that are blind, to free captives from prison and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness.
- 30) Isaiah 42:8 "I am the LORD; that is my name! I will not give my glory to another or my praise to idols.
- 31) Isaiah 42:16 I will lead the blind by ways they have not known, along unfamiliar paths I will guide them; I will turn the darkness into light before them and make the rough places smooth. These are the things I will do; I will not forsake them.
- 32) Isaiah 43:1 But now, this is what the LORD says—he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine.
- 33) Isaiah 43:2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.
- 34) Isaiah 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD, and apart from me there is no savior.
- 35) Isaiah 43:18 "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past.
- 36) Isaiah 43:19 See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland.
- 37) Isaiah 43:25 "I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more.
- 38) Isaiah 44:2 This is what the LORD says— he who made you, who formed you in the womb, and who will help you: Do not be afraid, O Jacob, my servant, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen.
- 39) Isaiah 44:3 For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out my Spirit on your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants.

- 40) Isaiah 44:6 "This is what the LORD says— Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD Almighty: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God.
- 41) Isaiah 45:6 so that from the rising of the sun to the place of its setting men may know there is none besides me. I am the LORD, and there is no other.
- 42) Isaiah 46:4 Even to your old age and gray hairs I am he, I am he who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you.
- 43) Isaiah 48:17 This is what the LORD says your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: "I am the LORD your God, who teaches you what is best for you, who directs you in the way you should go.
- 44) Isaiah 49:15 "Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Though she may forget, I will not forget you!
- 45) Isaiah 49:16 See, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands; your walls are ever before me.
- 46) Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!"
- 47) Isaiah 53:3 He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.
- 48) Isaiah 53:5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.
- 49) Isaiah 53:6 We all, like sheep, have gone astray; each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

- 50) Isaiah 54:10 Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor my covenant of peace be removed," says the LORD, who has compassion on you.
- 51) Isaiah 54:17 no weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and this is their vindication from me," declares the LORD.
- 52) Isaiah 55:8 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD.
- 53) Isaiah 55:9 "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.
- 54) Isaiah 55:10 As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater,
- 55) Isaiah 55:11 so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.
- 56) Isaiah 57:15 For this is what the high and lofty One says he who lives forever, whose name is holy: "I live in a high and holy place, but also with him who is contrite and lowly in spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly and to revive the heart of the contrite.
- 57) Isaiah 59:1 Surely the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear.
- 58) Isaiah 59:21 "As for me, this is my covenant with them," says the LORD. "My Spirit, who is on you, and my words that I have put in your mouth will not depart from your mouth, or from the mouths of your children, or from the mouths of their descendants from this time on and forever," says the LORD.

- 59) Isaiah 60:1 "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.
- 60) Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners,
- 61) Isaiah 61:2 to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn,
- 62) Isaiah 61:10 I delight greatly in the LORD; my soul rejoices in my God. For he has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom adorns his head like a priest, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.
- 63) Isaiah 64:4 Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides you, who acts on behalf of those who wait for him.
- 64) Isaiah 64:8 Yet, O LORD, you are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand.
- 65) Isaiah 66:1 This is what the LORD says: "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where is the house you will build for me? Where will my resting place be?
- 66) Isaiah 66:2 Has not my hand made all these things, and so they came into being?" declares the LORD. "This is the one I esteem: he who is humble and contrite in spirit, and trembles at my word.
- 67) Psalm 1:1 Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers.
- 68) Psalm 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.
- 69) Psalm 1:3 He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.

- 70) Psalm 1:4 Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.
- 71) Psalm 1:5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
- 72) Psalm 1:6 For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.
- 73) Psalm 2:8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.
- 74) Psalm 5:4 You are not a God who takes pleasure in evil; with you the wicked cannot dwell.
- 75) Psalm 5:7 But I, by your great mercy, will come into your house; in reverence will I bow down toward your holy temple.
- 76) Psalm 5:12 For surely, O LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.
- 77) Psalm 6:9 The LORD has heard my cry for mercy; the LORD accepts my prayer.
- 78) Psalm 7:17 I will give thanks to the LORD because of his righteousness and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High.
- 79) Psalm 8:1 O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.
- 80) Psalm 8:3 When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place,
- 81) Psalm 8:4 what is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him?
- 82) Psalm 9:1 I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonders.

- 83) Psalm 9:7 The LORD reigns forever; he has established his throne for judgment.
- 84) Psalm 9:9 The LORD is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble.
- 85) Psalm 9:10 Those who know your name will trust in you, for you, LORD, have never forsaken those who seek you.
- 86) Psalm 11:4 The LORD is in his holy temple; the LORD is on his heavenly throne. He observes the sons of men; his eyes examine them.
- 87) Psalm 15:1 LORD, who may dwell in your sanctuary? Who may live on your holy hill?
- 88) Psalm 15:2 He whose walk is blameless and who does what is righteous, who speaks the truth from his heart
- 89) Psalm 16:2 I said to the LORD, "You are my Lord; apart from you I have no good thing."
- 90) Psalm 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.
- 91) Psalm 17:8 Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings
- 92) Psalm 18:2 The LORD is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge. He is my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.
- 93) Psalm 18:27 You save the humble but bring low those whose eyes are haughty.
- 94) Psalm 18:29 With your help I can advance against a troop; with my God I can scale a wall.
- 95) Psalm 18:30 As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is flawless. He is a shield for all who take refuge in him.

- 96) Psalm 19:8 The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes.
- 97) Psalm 19:9 The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure and altogether righteous.
- 98) Psalm 19:14 May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer.
- 99) Psalm 20:6 Now I know that the LORD saves his anointed; he answers him from his holy heaven with the saving power of his right hand.
- 100) Psalm 20:7 Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.
- 101) Psalm 25:5 guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long.
- 102) Psalm 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?
- 103) Psalm 27:4 One thing I ask of the LORD, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.
- 104) Psalm 28:7 The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song.
- 105) Psalm 31:19 How great is your goodness, which you have stored up for those who fear you, which you bestow in the sight of men on those who take refuge in you.
- 106) Psalm 32:1 Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.
- 107) Proverbs 2:6 For the LORD gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding.

- 108) Proverbs 3:3 Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart.
- 109) Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;
- 110) Proverbs 3:6 in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.
- 111) Proverbs 3:7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil.
- 112) Proverbs 15:1 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.
- 113) Proverbs 15:13 A happy heart makes the face cheerful, but heartache crushes the spirit.
- 114) Proverbs 16:1 To man belong the plans of the heart, but from the LORD comes the reply of the tongue.
- 115) Proverbs 16:3 Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and your plans will succeed.
- 116) Proverbs 18:10 The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.
- 117) Proverbs 19:21 Many are the plans in a man's heart, but it is the LORD's purpose that prevails.
- 118) Proverbs 21:3 To do what is right and just is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.
- 119) Proverbs 22:4 Humility and the fear of the LORD bring wealth and honor and life.
- 120) Proverbs 27:1 Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth.
- 121) Proverbs 28:14 Blessed is the man who always fears the LORD, but he who hardens his heart falls into trouble.

- 122) Proverbs 29:25 Fear of man will prove to be a snare, but whoever trusts in the LORD is kept safe.
- 123) Proverbs 30:5 "Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.
- 124) Proverbs 31:8 "Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute.
- 125) Proverbs 31:30 Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised.
