Daniel (1 verse), Hosea (1 verse), Joel (8 verses); Total: 165 verses**

- 1) John 1:1 - In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- 2) John 1:2 - He was with God in the beginning.
- 3) John 1:3 - Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.
- 4) John 1:4 - In him was life, and that life was the light of men.
- 5) John 1:5 - The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it.
- 6) John 1:12 - Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God
- 7) John 3:3 - In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again.
- 8) John 3:5 - Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit.
- 9) John 3:6 - Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.

- 10) John 3:8 – The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."
- 11) John 3:16 – For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
- 12) John 3:17 – For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.
- 13) John 3:18 – Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.
- 14) John 3:34 – For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit.
- 15) John 3:35 – The Father loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands.
- 16) John 3:36 - Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him.
- 17) John 4:14 – But whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.
- 18) John 4:23 – Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.
- 19) John 4:24 – God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.
- 20) John 4:34 – My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work.
- 21) John 4:41 –And because of his words many more became believers.

- 22) John 4:42 – They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world.
- 23) John 5:17 – Jesus said to them, "My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I, too, am working.
- 24) John 5:19 – Jesus gave them this answer: "I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does.
- 25) John 5:24 – "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.
- 26) John 5:26 – For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself.
- 27) John 5:27 – And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man.
- 28) John 6:29 – Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent."
- 29) John 6:33 - For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."
- 30) John 6:35 - Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty.
- 31) John 6:40 - For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.
- 32) John 6:46 - No one has seen the Father except the one who is from God; only he has seen the Father.
- 33) John 6:47 - I tell you the truth, he who believes has everlasting life.

- 34) John 7:7 - The world cannot hate you, but it hates me because I testify that what it does is evil.
- 35) John 7:17 - If anyone chooses to do God's will, he will find out whether my teaching comes from God or whether I speak on my own.
- 36) John 8:34 - Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin.
- 37) John 10:10 - The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.
- 38) John 10:11 - "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.
- 39) John 10:14 - "I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me—
- 40) John 10:15 - just as the Father knows me and I know the Father—and I lay down my life for the sheep.
- 41) John 10:28 - I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.
- 42) John 10:29 - My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.
- 43) John 11:25 - Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies;
- 44) John 11:40 - Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?"
- 45) John 12:25 - The man who loves his life will lose it, while the man who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.
- 46) John 12:26 - Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honor the one who serves me.

- 47) John 12:46 - I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness.
- 48) John 13:16 - I tell you the truth, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him.
- 49) John 13:20 - I tell you the truth, whoever accepts anyone I send accepts me; and whoever accepts me accepts the one who sent me."
- 50) John 13:34 - "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.
- 51) John 13:35 - By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."
- 52) John 14:1 - "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me.
- 53) John 14:2 - In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you.
- 54) John 14:3 - And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.
- 55) John 14:6 - Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.
- 56) John 14:12 - I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.
- 57) John 14:13 - And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.
- 58) John 14:14 - You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.
- 59) John 14:15 - "If you love me, you will obey what I command.

- 60) John 14:20 - On that day you will realize that I am in my Father and you are in me, and I am in you.
- 61) John 15:1 - "I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener.
- 62) John 15:5 - "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.
- 63) John 15:7 - If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.
- 64) John 15:8 - This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.
- 65) John 16:13 - But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.
- 66) John 16:14 - He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you.
- 67) John 16:16 - "In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me."
- 68) John 17:9 - I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours.
- 69) John 17:19 - For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified.
- 70) John 20:21 - Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.
- 71) John 20:23 - If you forgive anyone his sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."
- 72) Romans 1:16 - I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.

- 73) Romans 1:22 - Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools
- 74) Romans 1:25 - They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen.
- 75) Romans 2:1 - You, therefore, have no excuse, you who pass judgment on someone else, for at whatever point you judge the other, you are condemning yourself, because you who pass judgment do the same things.
- 76) Romans 2:6 - God "will give to each person according to what he has done."
- 77) Romans 2:11 - For God does not show favoritism.
- 78) Romans 2:12 - All who sin apart from the law will also perish apart from the law, and all who sin under the law will be judged by the law.
- 79) Romans 2:13 - For it is not those who hear the law who are righteous in God's sight, but it is those who obey the law who will be declared righteous.
- 80) Romans 3:22 - This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference,
- 81) Romans 3:23 - for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- 82) Romans 3:24 - and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.
- 83) Romans 4:25 - He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.
- 84) Romans 5:1 - Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 85) Romans 5:2 - through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.

- 86) Romans 5:3 - Not only so, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;
- 87) Romans 5:4 - perseverance, character; and character, hope.
- 88) Romans 5:5 - And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us.
- 89) Romans 5:8 - But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- 90) Romans 5:12 - Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned
- 91) Romans 5:19 - For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.
- 92) Romans 6:4 - We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
- 93) Romans 6:5 - If we have been united with him like this in his death, we will certainly also be united with him in his resurrection.
- 94) Romans 6:8 - Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.
- 95) Romans 6:11 - In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.
- 96) Romans 6:12 - Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires.
- 97) Romans 6:14 - For sin shall not be your master, because you are not under law, but under grace.

- 98) Romans 6:18 - You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness.
- 99) Romans 6:22 - But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life.
- 100) Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 101) Romans 7:21 - So I find this law at work: When I want to do good, evil is right there with me.
- 102) Romans 7:22 - For in my inner being I delight in God's law;
- 103) Romans 8:1 - Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,
- 104) Romans 8:2 - because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.
- 105) Romans 8:6 - The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace;
- 106) Romans 8:8 - Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God.
- 107) Romans 8:9 - You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ.
- 108) Romans 8:10 - But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness.
- 109) Romans 8:11 - And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.
- 110) Romans 8:14 - because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

- 111) Romans 8:15 - For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."
- 112) Romans 8:16 - The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.
- 113) Romans 8:17 - Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.
- 114) Romans 8:18 - I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.
- 115) Romans 8:26 - In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express.
- 116) Romans 8:28 - And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
- 117) Romans 8:31 - What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us?
- 118) Romans 8:35 - Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword?
- 119) Romans 8:37 - No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.
- 120) Romans 8:38 - For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers,
- 121) Romans 8:39 - neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 122) Romans 10:9 - That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

- 123) Romans 10:10 - For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.
- 124) Isaiah 1:18 - "Come now, let us reason together," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.
- 125) Isaiah 1:19 - If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best from the land;
- 126) Isaiah 2:22 - Stop trusting in man, who has but a breath in his nostrils. Of what account is he?
- 127) Isaiah 9:6 - For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
- 128) Isaiah 11:1 - A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit.
- 129) Isaiah 11:2 - The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD -
- 130) Isaiah 11:3 - and he will delight in the fear of the LORD. He will not judge by what he sees with his eyes, or decide by what he hears with his ears;
- 131) Isaiah 11:5 - Righteousness will be his belt and faithfulness the sash around his waist.
- 132) Isaiah 12:2 - Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The LORD, the LORD, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation."
- 133) Isaiah 12:3 - With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.
- 134) Isaiah 12:4 - In that day you will say: "Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done, and proclaim that his name is exalted.

- 135) Isaiah 12:5 - Sing to the LORD, for he has done glorious things; let this be known to all the world.
- 136) Isaiah 40:4 - Every valley shall be raised up, every mountain and hill made low; the rough ground shall become level, the rugged places a plain.
- 137) Isaiah 40:5 - And the glory of the LORD will be revealed, and all mankind together will see it. For the mouth of the LORD has spoken."
- 138) Isaiah 40:12 - Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens? Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance?
- 139) Isaiah 40:13 - Who has understood the mind of the LORD, or instructed him as his counselor?
- 140) Isaiah 40:29 - He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.
- 141) Isaiah 40:30 - Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;
- 142) Isaiah 40:31 - but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
- 143) Isaiah 41:13 - For I am the LORD, your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you.
- 144) Isaiah 43:15 - I am the LORD, your Holy One, Israel's Creator, your King."
- 145) Isaiah 43:18 - "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past.
- 146) Isaiah 43:19 - See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland.
- 147) Isaiah 44:6 - "This is what the LORD says— Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD Almighty: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God.

- 148) Isaiah 55:6 - Seek the LORD while he may be found; call on him while he is near.
- 149) Isaiah 55:8 - "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD.
- 150) Isaiah 55:9 - "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.
- 151) Isaiah 55:11 - so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.
- 152) Isaiah 55:12 - You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands.
- 153) Isaiah 59:1 - Surely the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear.
- 154) Isaiah 59:2 - But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.
- 155) Isaiah 60:1 "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.
- 156) Daniel 2:21 - He changes times and seasons; he sets up kings and deposes them. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning.
- 157) Hosea 1:7 - Yet I will show love to the house of Judah; and I will save them—not by bow, sword or battle, or by horses and horsemen, but by the LORD their God."
- 158) Joel 2:1 - Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill. Let all who live in the land tremble, for the day of the LORD is coming. It is close at hand
- 159) Joel 2:13 - Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the LORD your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and bounding in love, and he relents from sending calamity.

- 160) Joel 2:21 - Be not afraid, O land; be glad and rejoice. Surely the LORD has done great things.
- 161) Joel 2:26 - You will have plenty to eat, until you are full, and you will praise the name of the LORD your God, who has worked wonders for you; never again will my people be shamed.
- 162) Joel 2:27 - Then you will know that I am in Israel, that I am the LORD your God, and that there is no other; never again will my people be shamed.
- 163) Joel 2:28 - "And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.
- 164) Joel 2:29 - Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days.
- 165) Joel 2:30 - I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and billows of smoke.
