- 1) Psalm 16:2 I said to the LORD, "You are my Lord; apart from you I have no good thing."
- 2) Psalm 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.
- 3) Psalm 17:8 Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings
- 4) Psalm 18:2 The LORD is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge. He is my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.
- 5) Psalm 18:27 You save the humble but bring low those whose eyes are haughty.
- 6) Psalm 18:29 With your help I can advance against a troop; with my God I can scale a wall.
- 7) Psalm 18:30 As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is flawless. He is a shield for all who take refuge in him.
- 8) Psalm 19:8 The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes.

- 9) Psalm 19:9 The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure and altogether righteous.
- 10) Psalm 19:14 May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer.
- 11) Psalm 20:6 Now I know that the LORD saves his anointed; he answers him from his holy heaven with the saving power of his right hand.
- 12) Psalm 20:7 Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.
- 13) Psalm 25:5 guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long.
- 14) Psalm 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?
- 15) Psalm 27:4 One thing I ask of the LORD, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.
- 16) Psalm 28:7 The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song.
- 17) Psalm 31:19 How great is your goodness, which you have stored up for those who fear you, which you bestow in the sight of men on those who take refuge in you.
- 18) Psalm 32:1 Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.
- 19) Isaiah 1:19 - If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best from the land;
- 20) Isaiah 2:22 - Stop trusting in man, who has but a breath in his nostrils. Of what account is he?

- 21) Isaiah 9:6 - For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
- 22) Isaiah 11:1 - A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit.
- 23) Isaiah 11:2 - The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD -
- 24) Isaiah 11:3 - and he will delight in the fear of the LORD. He will not judge by what he sees with his eyes, or decide by what he hears with his ears;
- 25) Isaiah 11:5 - Righteousness will be his belt and faithfulness the sash around his waist.
- 26) Isaiah 12:2 - Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The LORD, the LORD, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation."
- 27) Isaiah 12:3 - With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.
- 28) Isaiah 12:4 - In that day you will say: "Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done, and proclaim that his name is exalted.
- 29) Isaiah 12:5 - Sing to the LORD, for he has done glorious things; let this be known to all the world.
- 30) Isaiah 40:4 - Every valley shall be raised up, every mountain and hill made low; the rough ground shall become level, the rugged places a plain.
- 31) Isaiah 40:5 - And the glory of the LORD will be revealed, and all mankind together will see it. For the mouth of the LORD has spoken."

- 32) Isaiah 40:12 - Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens? Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance?
- 33) Isaiah 40:13 - Who has understood the mind of the LORD, or instructed him as his counselor?
- 34) Isaiah 40:29 - He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.
- 35) Isaiah 40:30 - Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;
- 36) Isaiah 40:31 - but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
- 37) Isaiah 41:13 - For I am the LORD, your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you.
- 38) Isaiah 43:15 - I am the LORD, your Holy One, Israel's Creator, your King."
- 39) Isaiah 43:18 - "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past.
- 40) Isaiah 43:19 - See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland.
- 41) Isaiah 44:6 - "This is what the LORD says— Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD Almighty: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God.
- 42) Isaiah 55:6 - Seek the LORD while he may be found; call on him while he is near.
- 43) Isaiah 55:8 - "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD.
- 44) Isaiah 55:9 - "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

- 45) Isaiah 55:11 - so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.
- 46) Isaiah 55:12 - You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands.
- 47) Isaiah 59:1 - Surely the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear.
- 48) Isaiah 59:2 - But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.
- 49) Isaiah 60:1 "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.
- 50) Matthew 4:4 Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"
- 51) Matthew 4:7 Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'"
- 52) Matthew 4:10 Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'"
- 53) Matthew 4:17 From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near."
- 54) Matthew 4:19 "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men."
- 55) Matthew 4:20 At once they left their nets and followed him.
- 56) Matthew 5:3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 57) Matthew 5:4 Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- 58) Matthew 5:5 Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.

- 59) Matthew 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- 60) Matthew 5:7 Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
- 61) Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.
- 62) Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.
- 63) Matthew 5:10 Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 64) Matthew 5:11 "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me.
- 65) Matthew 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.
- 66) Matthew 5:37 Simply let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one.
- 67) Matthew 5:42 Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you.
- 68) Matthew 5:44 But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,
- 69) Matthew 6:1 "Be careful not to do your 'acts of righteousness' before men, to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven.
- 70) Matthew 6:3 But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing,
- 71) Matthew 6:14 For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.

- 72) Matthew 6:20 But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.
- 73) Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
- 74) Matthew 6:22 "The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are good, your whole body will be full of light.
- 75) Matthew 6:27 Who of you by worrying can add a single hour to his life[\[a\]](#)?
- 76) Matthew 6:33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
- 77) Matthew 7:1 "Do not judge, or you too will be judged.
- 78) Matthew 7:2 For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.
- 79) Matthew 7:7 "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.
- 80) Matthew 7:8 For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened.
- 81) Matthew 7:14 But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.
- 82) Matthew 7:17 Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.
- 83) Matthew 7:20 Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them.
- 84) Matthew 7:21 "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.
- 85) Matthew 8:26 He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.

- 86) Matthew 9:29 Then he touched their eyes and said, "According to your faith will it be done to you";
- 87) Matthew 9:37 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few.
- 88) Matthew 10:16 I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves.
- 89) Matthew 10:22 All men will hate you because of me, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.
- 90) Matthew 10:32 "Whoever acknowledges me before men, I will also acknowledge him before my Father in heaven.
- 91) Matthew 10:37 "Anyone who loves his father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; anyone who loves his son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me;
- 92) Matthew 10:38 and anyone who does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me.
- 93) Matthew 10:39 Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.
- 94) Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
- 95) Matthew 11:29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
- 96) Matthew 11:30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."
- 97) Matthew 12:30 "He who is not with me is against me, and he who does not gather with me scatters.
- 98) Matthew 12:50 For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother."

- 99) Matthew 13:12 Whoever has will be given more, and he will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken from him.
- 100) Matthew 14:27 But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid."
- 101) Matthew 14:31 Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"
- 102) Matthew 15:11 What goes into a man's mouth does not make him 'unclean,' but what comes out of his mouth, that is what makes him 'unclean.' "
- 103) Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.
- 104) Matthew 16:25 whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it.
- 105) Matthew 16:26 What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul?
- 106) Matthew 16:27 For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done.
- 107) Matthew 18:3 And he said: "I tell you the truth, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.
- 108) Matthew 18:4 Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
- 109) Matthew 18:20 For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them."
- 110) Matthew 19:14 Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

- 111) Matthew 19:24 Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."
- 112) Matthew 19:26 Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
- 113) Matthew 20:16 "So the last will be first, and the first will be last."
- 114) Matthew 20:26 Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant,
- 115) Matthew 21:22 If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer."
- 116) Matthew 22:37 Jesus replied: " 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.'
- 117) Matthew 22:38 This is the first and greatest commandment.
- 118) Matthew 22:39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'[\[a\]](#)
- 119) Matthew 23:12 For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.
- 120) Matthew 24:13 but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.
- 121) Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.
- 122) Matthew 24:36 "No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.
- 123) Matthew 24:42 "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come.
- 124) Matthew 25:45 "He will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.'

- 125) Matthew 28:19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- 126) Romans 1:16 - I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.
- 127) Romans 1:22 - Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools
- 128) Romans 1:25 - They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen.
- 129) Romans 2:1 - You, therefore, have no excuse, you who pass judgment on someone else, for at whatever point you judge the other, you are condemning yourself, because you who pass judgment do the same things.
- 130) Romans 2:6 - God "will give to each person according to what he has done."
- 131) Romans 2:11 - For God does not show favoritism.
- 132) Romans 2:12 - All who sin apart from the law will also perish apart from the law, and all who sin under the law will be judged by the law.
- 133) Romans 2:13 - For it is not those who hear the law who are righteous in God's sight, but it is those who obey the law who will be declared righteous.
- 134) Romans 3:22 - This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference,
- 135) Romans 3:23 - for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- 136) Romans 3:24 - and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.
- 137) Romans 4:25 - He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.

- 138) Romans 5:1 - Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 139) Romans 5:2 - through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.
- 140) Romans 5:3 - Not only so, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;
- 141) Romans 5:4 - perseverance, character; and character, hope.
- 142) Romans 5:5 - And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us.
- 143) 1 Peter 1:13 Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed.
- 144) 1 Peter 1:14 As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance.
- 145) 1 Peter 1:15 But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do;
- 146) 1 Peter 1:16 for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."
- 147) 1 Peter 1:23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.
- 148) 1 Peter 1:24 For, "All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall,
- 149) 1 Peter 1:25 but the word of the Lord stands forever." And this is the word that was preached to you.
- 150) 1 Peter 2:1 Therefore, rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind.

- 151) 1 Peter 2:2 Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation,
- 152) 1 Peter 2:3 now that you have tasted that the Lord is good.
- 153) 1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
- 154) 1 Peter 2:10 Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.
- 155) 1 Peter 2:16 Live as free men, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; live as servants of God.
- 156) 1 Peter 2:17 Show proper respect to everyone: Love the brotherhood of believers, fear God, honor the king.
- 157) 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble.
- 158) 1 Peter 3:9 Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult, but with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.
- 159) 1 Peter 3:10 For, "Whoever would love life and see good days must keep his tongue from evil and his lips from deceitful speech.
- 160) 1 Peter 3:11 He must turn from evil and do good; he must seek peace and pursue it.
- 161) 1 Peter 3:12 For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."
- 162) 1 Peter 4:1 Therefore, since Christ suffered in his body, arm yourselves also with the same attitude, because he who has suffered in his body is done with sin.
- 163) 1 Peter 4:2 As a result, he does not live the rest of his earthly life for evil human desires, but rather for the will of God.

- 164) 1 Peter 4:6 For this is the reason the gospel was preached even to those who are now dead, so that they might be judged according to men in regard to the body, but live according to God in regard to the spirit.
- 165) 1 Peter 4:12 Dear friends, do not be surprised at the painful trial you are suffering, as though something strange were happening to you.
- 166) 1 Peter 4:13 But rejoice that you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed.
- 167) 1 Peter 4:14 If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you.
- 168) 1 Peter 4:15 If you suffer, it should not be as a murderer or thief or any other kind of criminal, or even as a meddler.
- 169) 1 Peter 4:16 However, if you suffer as a Christian, do not be ashamed, but praise God that you bear that name.
- 170) 1 Peter 5:6 Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time.
- 171) 1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
- 172) 1 Peter 5:8 Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.
- 173) 1 Peter 5:9 Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings.
- 174) 1 Peter 5:10 And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.
- 175) 1 Peter 5:11 To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen.
